

Process Statement: Wring Fiction

During our unit on fiction, we learned to write fiction stories in two different ways. The first stories that we wrote, we began by writing small moments stories about our actual lives. Then we re-read our small moments stories and thought "what if..." and imagined something that could have happened, but didn't. Then we added on to our stories, imagining that our "what if..." had actually happened. We thought of at least three "what if..." parts to add to our stories. Then we published them by re-reading them, making sure our writing was clear, checking for sight words, making our illustrations beautiful, and adding more details.

On our second stories, we made up characters, and imagined things that could happen to them. We started by writing descriptions of our characters, and then imagined problems they could have, and things that could have happened to them.
